- Junior classes start at 8.15am and conclude at 10.15am. Year 12 classes start at 9:00am and conclude at 12:15pm. Year 11 classes start at 10:15am and conclude at 1:30pm.

Polish Junior class is from 8:00am to 10:00am and Year 11 and 12 Polish class is from 10:15am to 1:30pm

The Year 12 Spanish Extension class starts at 8am and concludes at 9am

- All students must attend each Saturday of the school term, regardless of the end of term date of their weekday school.
- Students absent from classes must submit a note upon return from the parent explaining the reason for the absence. Late arrivals and early leavers must also be accompanied by a note of explanation. Any student anticipating a family vacation must inform the centre in writing prior to departure with a list of the anticipated dates. Any leave must take into account any missed assessment tasks and be clarified with the classroom teacher and the centre supervisor for alternative arrangements.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited.
- Students leaving the centre early must sign out at the Saturday School Office before departing.
- No responsibility can be taken for students leaving centre grounds without permission.
