Your responsibility is to treat others with fairness and respect. 	<p>Students will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Accept responsibility for the choices they make Treat all people with respect Follow teachers' instructions at all times Use appropriate language at all times
<p>Care for your own and school property</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your right is for your property to be safe and secure. Your responsibility is to look after school property. 	<p>Students will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be responsible for looking after their own property and school property. Treat school property and school environment with respect.
<p>Behave Safely</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your right is to be safe and happy at school. Your responsibility is to act in ways which keep yourself and others safe. 	<p>Students will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remain on school grounds at all times unless they have permission to leave from executive staff. Follow all WHS (Work Health and Safety) procedures at the centre. Act responsibly and access only appropriate sites and materials on the internet.
